Race Group will be Unlimited, Modified, and Prepared.

Time Trials will be GT 1, -2, -3.

Classes will be assigned at the event. Emphasis for this event is on sportsmanship and camaraderie. Awards will be presented at the banquet on Saturday, Sunday results will be announced without a formal presentation.

Car Show Vipers:

All Vipers registered for the event can participate in the Friday car show from 10 to 1:00. Race and track Vipers will be judged also where they are displayed and or parked.

Track Schedule:

Wednesday's practice session is not part of the Viper Days event.
